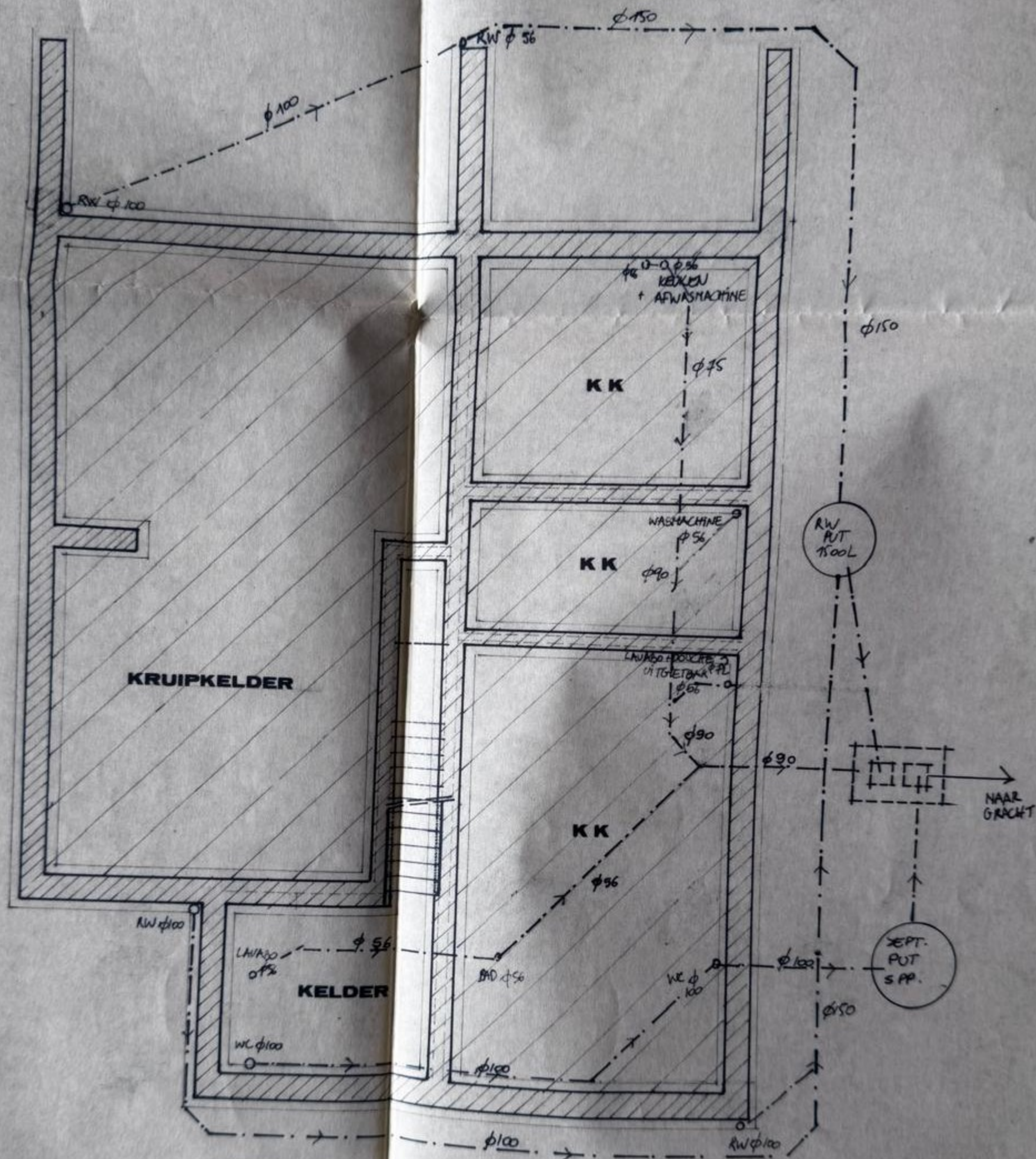
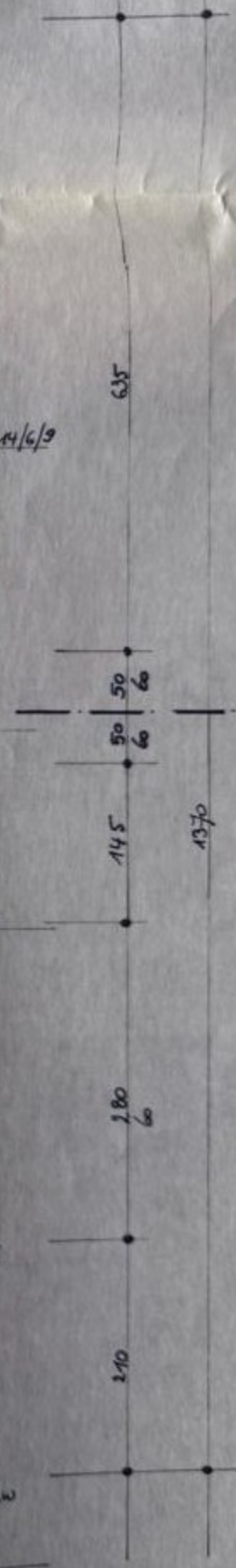
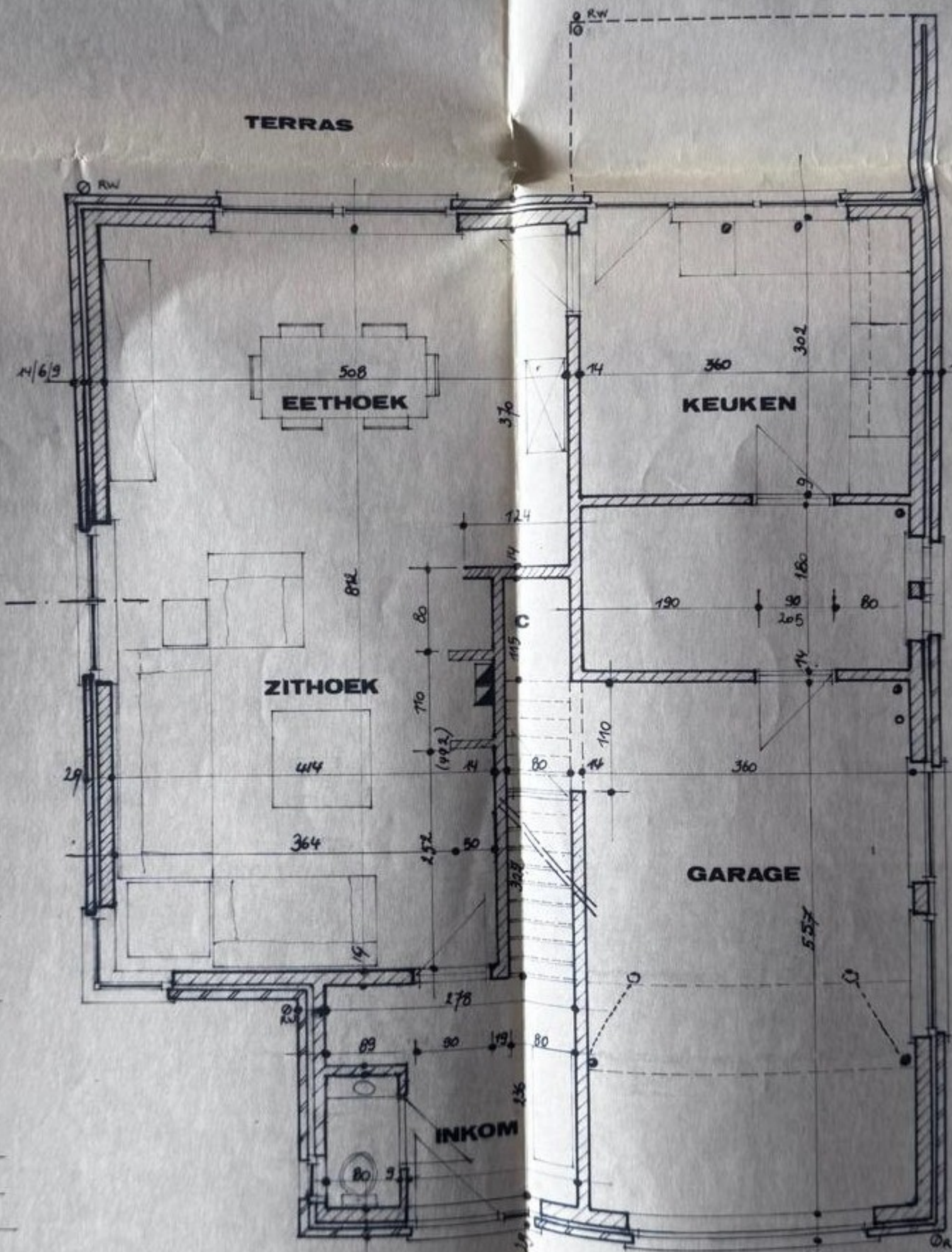
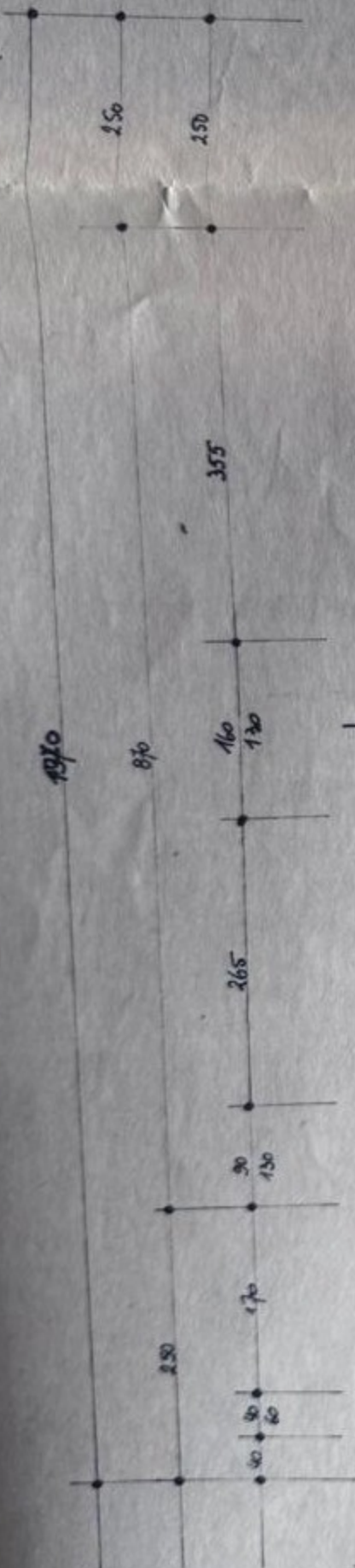

GRONDPLAN
